ORDINANCE NUMBER 352

An Ordinance amending Ordinance Number 324 entitled:

"An Ordinance licensing, regulating and controlling the manufacture, sale and distribution of non-intoxicating malt and vinous beverages; fixing the amount of license fees; providing for revocation of licenses; providing other terms and conditions; providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and declaring an emergency."

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That sub-section 9 of Section VI be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

9. It shall be unlawful for a retailer to suffer or permit any person to consume non-intoxicating beverages on or in his premises unless said person consumes said non-intoxicating beverages while seated at a table, or while seated at a counter where meals are ordinarily served. It shall also be unlawful for any retailer to suffer or permit any person to consume non-intoxicating beverages in any room or place which is obscured by a partition, wall, furniture, curtain, or other obstacle from plain view from the street.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to sell, give away, or otherwise dispose of non-intoxicating beverages between the hours of one o'clock A.M. and seven o'clock A.M. of each day.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to sell, give away, or otherwise dispose of non-intoxicating beverages to any person who is intoxicated or who is under the influence of intoxicating liquor.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the Town of Milwaukee in this: That it appears that sales of non-intoxicating beverages have been made to persons under the influence of intoxicating liquors, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
