THE DOES ORLAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation  
... owner, agent or lessee to operate, or allow to be operated  
... commonly known as a slot machine within the corporate limits  
... kkie; provided, however, this ordinance shall not apply to  
... owing devices operated upon the insertion of a coin:-

A vending machine, the sole purpose of which is to return  
... to the person inserting the coin, upon each insertion, value  
... in the form of merchandise.

Devices or machines used for amusement or for playing a  
... game and commonly known and referred to as pin ball machines.

3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this or-  
... shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not  
... g \$100.00 or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding sixty  
... s, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
