

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 2 of Ordinance Number 140 for reduction of rates on water effective July 1, 1936 and Ordinance Number 351 and all other ordinances and parts in conflict herewith.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance Number 140 be, and is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. That on and after the first day of July following rates be charged to each customer and/or user of Milwaukee Water Department:

Minimum charge for water per connection with city water lines each user and/or customer located within the city boundaries. \$1.80 per two months period

Minimum charge for water per connection with city water lines each user and/or customer located without the city boundaries. \$2.80 per two months period

Each user and/or customer shall be allowed 800 cubic feet of water for minimum rate for each two months period.

For all quantities of water used and/or metered to the particular premises of the user and/or customer in excess of 800 cubic feet the rate charged shall be as follows:

(1) Twelve (12) cents per hundred cubic feet to each user and/or customer located within the city boundaries.

(2) Twenty-two (22) cents per hundred cubic feet to each user and/or customer located without the city boundaries. Provided, however, users and/or customers located without the city boundaries who use in excess of twenty-two hundred cubic feet per two months period shall be charged for such excess twelve cents per hundred cubic feet.

For the purposes of this Ordinance the location of the premises supplied shall determine the location of the user and/or customer.

2. That Ordinance Number 351 be and the same is hereby re-
