

## ORDINANCE NO. 396

An Ordinance providing for a special election to be held on the 1st day of December, 1939, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Milwaukie for their acceptance or rejection a proposal to annex certain property generally described as Robertson and Birkemeier additions, Clackamas County, State of Oregon.

## MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That a special election be held on the first day of December, 1939, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Milwaukie for their acceptance or rejection a proposal to annex the following described property territory, to wit:-

Beginning in the southwesterly boundary of the city limits of the town of Milwaukie, as the same exist at this date (October 1, 1939), at the point of intersection where the line between Lots 19 and 20 of Block 56 of the plat of Milwaukie Heights, Clackamas County Townplat recorded in Volume 4 on Page 28, Record of Townplats, intersects said city limits if extended northeasterly; thence southwest along the line directing Lots 19 and 20 of Block 56 of said plat of Milwaukie Heights and the northeasterly extension thereof to the most southerly corner of aforementioned Lot 19, which southerly corner is located in the northeasterly boundary of Railway Avenue in said plat of Milwaukie Heights; thence northwest along the northeasterly boundary of said Railway Avenue to its point of intersection with the easterly extension of the North boundary of 5th Street of the said plat of Milwaukie Heights; thence westerly along the north boundary of said 5th Street and the easterly extension thereof to the southeast corner of Block 4 of the plat of Robertson, a Clackamas County townplat recorded in Volume 1 on Page 25, Record of Townplats; thence north to the southeast corner of Block 5 of the said plat of Robertson; thence west along the south boundary of Blocks 5-6-15-16-24-25 and 27 of the said plat of Robertson to the westerly extension of the south boundary of said Block 27 to the meanders of the right bank of the Willamette River as the same is established by the United States Government survey; thence northerly following the meanders of the Willamette River to the most westerly southwest corner of the city limits of the town of Milwaukie as established at this date (October 1, 1939); thence easterly and southeasterly following the southerly and southwesterly city limits of Milwaukie to the place of beginning of the area herein described, which place situate in Clackamas County, Oregon.

Section 2. The following named places are hereby designated as the polling places for said election, and the following named persons are hereby designated and appointed as Judges and Clerks of election, to act at said polling place for said election on said date, to wit:-

Ward Number 1. Polling place, City Hall in Milwaukie, C. H. Counsell, Chairman; Nellie M. Webster and Annie B. Adams, Judges; and Laura M. Meade and Minnie D. Shrock, Clerks.

Ward Number 2. Polling place, Fire Hall in Milwaukie, on Railroad Avenue, Alice Rigdon, Chairman; and De Etta Kelso and Maude Bevington, Judges; and Dorothy Fields and Icella McClure, Clerks.
