

## ORDINANCE NO. 399

AN ORDINANCE providing for a special election to be held on the 17th day of May, 1940, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Milwaukie, for their acceptance or rejection a proposal to amend the Charter of Milwaukie, filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 11, 1905, and to amend all Acts amending said Act by providing that the Council of Milwaukie may incur an indebtedness not to exceed \$12,000. for the purpose of constructing a reservoir and making improvements to the water distribution system; providing further that said indebtedness shall be paid from funds secured from the operation of the City Water System, and providing further designation of the polling places, judges and clerks of election.

## MILWAUKIE Does Ordain As Follows:-

Section 1. That a special election be held on the 17th day of May, 1940, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Milwaukie for their acceptance or rejection the following proposals:-

## AN ACT

To amend an Act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie in Clackamas County Oregon, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict therewith, to wit: 'An Act to incorporate the Town of Milwaukie in Clackamas County, Oregon' passed by the 22nd regular session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon and approved by the Governor on February 4, 1903, passed by the 23rd session of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, and filed in the office of the Secretary of State February 11, 1905, as amended by all amendments to said Act adopted by the Legislative Assembly or by vote of the people by adding thereto Section 86, to read as follows:

Section 86. The council of Milwaukie is hereby authorized to borrow money and incur indebtedness in a sum not to exceed Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of constructing and providing a water reservoir or other storage and making improvements to the city water distribution system; provided that any debt incurred pursuant to the authority hereof shall be paid from funds secured from the operation of the City Water System.

Section 2. The following named places are hereby designated as the polling places for said election, and the following named are hereby designated and appointed as and for judges and clerks of election, to act at said polling places for said election, and said date, to-wit:

WARD NO. 1. Polling place, City Hall, 926 Main Street Milwaukie, Oregon:

Middle Llewellyn, Chairman; A. H. Gauger and Pearl Wissinger, Judges; and Clyde Lamb and Edith Jones, Clerks.

WARD NO. 2. Polling place Fire Hall in East Milwaukie Railroad Avenue, Ralph Geil, Chairman, Ora Mazzei and Minerva Jones, Judges; and Minnie Roetter and Olive Cates, Clerks.
