

ORDINANCE NO. 410

An Ordinance providing for the vacation of Harvey's First Addition to the Town of Milwaukie, with certain exceptions.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Council of Milwaukie on Monday, the 27th day of January, 1941, pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 259, Oregon Laws 1939, in relation to the proposed vacation of the following described property:

Plat of Harvey's 1st Addition to the town of Milwaukie, Ore. (T. 1 S.R. 1, E.W.M.) as recorded in Book 17, Page 4, Plat Records of Clackamas County, Oregon, excepting that part within the present boundaries of 32nd Street, lying on the Easterly side of said platted property.

WHEREAS, there were no objections or remonstrances filed or presented regarding said proposed plat vacation, and it appearing that notice has been duly given by publishing and posting the same as required by law, and it further appearing that the vacation of said plat is in the public interest, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced in any respect; now, therefore,

Milwaukie Does Ordain As Follows

Section 1. That

Plat of Harvey's 1st Addition to the town of Milwaukie, Ore. (T. 1 S.R. 1, E.W.M.) as recorded in Book 17, Page 4, Plat Records of Clackamas County, Oregon, excepting that part within the present boundaries of 32nd Street, lying on the Easterly side of said platted property,

be, and the same is hereby declared to be vacated.
