

ORDINANCE NO. 415

An Ordinance providing for the regulation of special police officers.

Milwaukie Does Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. The term "special police officer" as used herein means, and shall be construed to mean, any person engaged in nightwatch work or other police work whose compensation is paid in whole or in part by private individuals, persons, firms or corporations.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, with the exception of State and County police officers, to engage in nightwatch work or other police work in Milwaukie without having first secured the permission of the City Council so to do.

Section 3. Any person desiring to become a "special police officer" shall first make application to the Mayor for permission to do so. The Mayor shall, in cooperation with the City Marshal, make investigation of all such applications. If the Mayor and City Marshal find upon such investigation that the person making application is a responsible person of good moral character and is assured of a remuneration of not less than Sixty (\$60.00) dollars per month, they may (and only on finding such conditions to exist may they) recommend to the Council that such person be appointed a special police officer.

Section 4. Upon receiving the recommendation of the Mayor and City Marshal, the Council may appoint the person so applying, imposing such restrictions as to the Council may seem advisable.

Section 5. The appointment of any special police officer may be revoked at any time in the discretion of the Council.

Section 6. The appointment of any special police officer does not mean and shall not be construed as meaning that Milwaukee or any officials or employes thereof accept any responsibility nor in any sense shall be liable at law, in equity or otherwise for any acts or omissions of any special police officer.

Section 7. All actions by the Council hereunder shall require an affirmative vote of three of the members of the City Council.

Section 8. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dollars.
