

ORDINANCE NO. 419

An ordinance granting a ~~five~~^{one} year franchise to collect garbage to the Pacific Sanitary Service Company.

Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Pacific Sanitary Service Co., an Oregon corporation, is hereby empowered and duly authorized for a period of ~~five~~ years, commencing the first day of January, 1942, to operate the business of collecting or removing garbage, swill, offal, dead animals, tin cans, and all similar waste in the City of Milwaukie, County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, under the following maximum terms and rates:

Section 2. Disposal of tin cans, glass, broken bottles, excluding garbage, placed in containers not to exceed 25 gallons, once a month service at 25 cents a month.

Section 3. Disposal of garbage, refuse, cans, glass, etc., placed in container.

Additional quantities picked up at the time of regular trip, the charges will be twenty-five cents, (25¢) for each quantity of 25 gallons or less, in excess of regular container.

Disposal of old water boilers, bed springs or bed each .50
Disposal of dead animals: Cats or dogs each .50

Section 6. That the said Pacific Sanitary Service Company shall, at its expense, maintain a place satisfactory to the City Council for the disposal of all the garbage collected under this franchise, in a sanitary condition at all times.

Section 7. That the said Pacific Sanitary Service Company shall maintain a telephone with an attendant during regular business hours.

Section 8. That the Pacific Sanitary Service Company agrees to pay to the City of Milwaukie a franchise fee of ~~\$50.00~~^{25.00} per year, the same to be due and payable on or before the 15th day of January of each year.
