

ORDINANCE NO. 431

An ordinance regulating the setting or maintenance of outside fires in Milwaukie, requiring a permit therefor, providing a penalty for violation, and repealing Ordinance No. 103.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person, firm, or corporation shall:

- a. Set or start a fire burning uncut grass or brush or any other type of running fire, within the corporate limits of Milwaukie.
- b. Set or start, or allow to continue, any outside fire not wholly covered and blacked out, except during the hours of daylight only.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation shall set or start any fire, except those necessary for building heating, household cooking or industrial purposes in lawful stoves, fire pots and furnaces, unless such person, firm or corporation shall have first complied with the following requirements.

- a. Secured a permit from the Chief of the Milwaukie Fire Department, or his duly authorized representative.
- b. Provided a connected garden hose or wet sacks and such other fire fighting equipment as the Chief of the Fire Department may require.

Section 3. The fire permit mentioned in Section 2 hereof shall be for such period of time as the Fire Chief shall determine, except that in no event may it be longer than five days. Such fire permit may be revoked by written order of the Fire Chief or his duly authorized representative at any time.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation setting or starting a fire pursuant to a permit issued by the Fire Chief shall constantly attend and supervise the same and shall completely extinguish the same upon leaving said fire.

Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon pleading guilty or conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100).

Section 6. Ordinance No. 103 and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
