

ORDINANCE NO. 433

An ordinance providing for the regulation of the erection or placing of tents, automotive trailer houses, trailer houses, portable houses or other portable buildings in Milwaukie, and repealing all other ordinances in conflict herewith.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall erect or place any tent, automotive trailer house, trailer house, portable house or other portable building in Milwaukie without first having obtained a permit from the Fire Chief.

Section 2. Before a permit for the erection or placing of any tent, automotive trailer house, trailer house, portable house or other portable building, as required by Section 1 hereof, may be issued by the Fire Chief, he must find that the following conditions have been or will be immediately complied with:

- a. That adequate and sanitary garbage and sewage disposal facilities have been provided for, if the use of the structure is such as to require same.
- b. That the erecting or placing of such structure will not create a public nuisance.
- c. That the erecting or placing of such structure will not result in the violation of any Federal or State law, rule or regulation or of any other Milwaukie Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars

(\$10.00 nor more than One Hundred Dollars(\$100.00). Each day's violation of this Ordinance shall be construed to be a separate violation.
