

ORDINANCE NO. 446

An Ordinance regulating the businesses of hospitals, convalescent homes, homes for the aged and infirm in Milwaukee and providing for the licensing of such establishments.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Each person, firm or corporation conducting or maintaining a hospital, convalescent home, home for the aged, home for the infirm or similar establishment in Milwaukee for a charge or fee shall conform to the following requirements:

a. Pay a license fee of \$500.00 per annum in four quarterly payments of \$125.00 each, payable respectively on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year. Any such establishment commencing operations during the interim of any quarter shall pay proportionately.

b. Shall conform to all requirements of sanitation and health as prescribed by the City Health Officer and as approved by the Council.

c. Shall conform to all requirements of safety and fire as prescribed by the Fire Chief and as approved by the Council.

Section 2. The City Health Officer shall examine any premises in and upon which a hospital, convalescent home, home for the aged, home for the infirmed or other such establishment is maintained or operated, at least once a month for sanitation and health purposes and shall report findings of each such inspection to the Council within three days after such inspection is made. The Fire Chief shall likewise inspect and report as to safety and fire matters on each such establishment.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine of not less than ten (\$10.00) dollars nor more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars for each day the violation occurs or continues.
