

ORDINANCE NO. 449

AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a portion of Twenty-ninth street, which lies in Sellwood's Addition to Quincy Addition, Milwaukie.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Council of Milwaukie on the 14th day of August 1944, pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 259, Oregon Laws 1939, in relation to the proposed vacation of the following street or street area:

That portion of Twenty-ninth street which lies between the south boundary of Washington street and the North boundary of Madison street in Sellwood's Addition to Quincy Addition, Milwaukie, and

Whereas, there were no objections or remonstrances filed or presented regarding said proposed street vacation, and it appearing that notice has been duly given by publishing and posting the same as required by law, and it further appearing that the vacation of said street is in the public interest and that the public interest will not be prejudiced in any respect, now, therefore:

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following street or street area, to-wit:

That portion of Twenty-ninth street which lies between the south boundary of Washington street and the north boundary of Madison street in Sellwood's Addition to Quincy Addition, Milwaukie

be and the same is hereby declared to be vacated.
