

ORDINANCE NUMBER 458

An Ordinance providing for a special election to be held on the ninth day of February, 1945 pursuant to the provisions of Section 37 of "Proposal to Enact New City Charter" adopted by the voters of Milwaukee at the election on November 7, 1944 and for the purpose of electing officers called for by said new City Charter.

MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special election be held on the ninth day of February, 1945, pursuant to the provisions of Section 37 of the City Charter adopted by the voters of Milwaukee at a special election held on the seventh day of November, 1944 and for the purpose of electing five council members.

Section 2. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes at the election hereby called shall each hold office until December 31, 1948 and the three receiving the next greatest number of votes shall hold office until December 31, 1946.

Section 3. The following named places are hereby designated as the polling places for said election, and the following named are hereby designatee and appointed as and for judges and clerks of election, to act at said polling places for said election on said date, to-wit:

Ward Number 1. Precinct 1. Polling Place, Union High School, 23rd and Willard Streets, in said Milwaukee. Bernice Sperr, Katrine Jensen and Mary Kemmerer; Judges; Myrtle E. Byers and Emma Hildenbrand, Clerks.

Ward Number 1. Precinct 3. Polling Place, City Hall 226 Main street in said Milwaukee. Sadie Lewellyn, Harry Dean and Myrtle Council, Judges; Florence Salter and Ada Roberts Clerks.

Ward Number 1. Precinct Kellogg Park. Polling Place, Administration Building, Kellogg Park, in said Milwaukee, E.D. Severance Agnes Smith and Row Falthorp, Judges; Sylvia Wickland and Margaret Blackerby, Clerks.

Ward Number 2. Precinct 2. Polling Place, 1406 31st Street in said Milwaukee, Alice Rigdon, Marion N. Mariman, Josephine Countryman, Judges; Hubert Farnham and Ora Mazzei Clerks.

Ward Number 2. Precinct 4. Polling Place, Minthorn Community Church, 40th and Llewellyn streets in said Milwaukee, Dorothy C. Fields, Minerva Jones and Inez Binn, Judges; Ora DeVee and Letta Maple, Clerks.

Ward Number 2. Precinct 5. Polling Place, Administration Building, Hillside Park, in said Milwaukee. Hilda Burdick, Dora Coppock and Magda Lenox, Judges; Rose M. Neidemeyer and Marjorie Baxter, Clerks.
