

ORDINANCE NUMBER 463

AN ORDINANCE providing a tax levy on all taxable property within the city of MILWAUKIE, Oregon, for city purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1945 and ending June 30, 1946.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby levied upon all taxable property situate within the corporate limits of Milwaukie, Oregon, a tax levy of Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred Twenty-seven Dollars and Eighty-two cents (\$19,627.82) for city purposes for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1945 and ending June 30, 1946, and that said tax be apportioned among the several funds and departments as set forth and specified in the estimated budget of expenditures for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1945 and ending June 30, 1946, as prepared by the Budget Committee of Milwaukie, which estimated budget in words and figures reads as follows:
