

ORDINANCE NUMBER 466

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF THAT PART OF CHERRY STREET WHICH LIES NORTH OF BLOCK 2, SOUTH OF BLOCK 3, EAST OF THE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, AND WEST OF THIRTY-FIRST STREET IN GALLOP ADDITION MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, AND RECORDED IN BOOK 15 ON PAGE 11, RECORD OF TOWN PLATS FOR CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Council of Milwaukie on Monday, the thirteenth day of August, 1945, pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 259, Oregon Laws 1939, in relation to the proposed vacation of the following street:

That part of Cherry street which lies north of Block 2, south of Block 3, east of the Right-of-Way of the Southern Pacific Company, and west of Thirty-first street in Gallop Addition Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, and recorded in Book 15 on Page 11, Record of Town Plats for Clackamas County, Oregon.

WHEREAS, there were no objections or remonstrances filed or presented regarding said proposed street vacation, and it appearing that notice has been duly given by publishing and posting the same as required by law, and it further appearing that the vacation of said street is in the public interest and that the public will not be prejudiced in any respect, now, therefore:

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1, That the following street, to-wit:

That part of Cherry street which lies north of Block 2, south of Block 3, east of the Right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Company, and west of Thirty-first street Gallop Addition Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, and recorded in Book 15 on Page 11, Record of Town Plats for Clackamas County, Oregon,

be and the same is hereby declared to be vacated.
