

ORDINANCE NO 475

AN ORDINANCE establishing certain through streets or portions of streets in Milwaukie and requiring the erection of stop signs, so as to indicate the same, and requiring vehicles entering such through streets to come to a complete stop at such points, and repealing Ordinance Number 390.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following streets and portions of streets hereby are declared to be "Through Streets":

- (a) Front Street for its entire length
- (b) Lake Road for its entire length
- (c) Harrison Street from the west line of Main Street east to the City Limits
- (d) Washington Street from the west line of 21st Street to the east line of 30th Street
- (e) Monroe Street where the same is intersected by 29th Street and from the easterly line of Railroad Avenue easterly to the City Limits.
- (f) Oak Street where the same is intersected by Railroad Avenue.
- (g) 42nd Street where the same is intersected by Harrison St.
