

ORDINANCE NO. ~~432~~.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE MANNER IN WHICH VEHICLE MAY BE
PARKED: AND DECLARING IT UNLAWFUL TO PARK VEHICLES IN ANY OTHER
MANNER: AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:*

Sec. 1. All vehicles parked or stopped on the streets of the
City of Milwaukie, which have been designated for parallel parking,
shall be so parked or stopped that no part of said vehicle or its
load shall be over 9 feet from the curb line; excepting therefrom
such vehicles as may be stopped pursuant to traffic regulations.

Section 2. All vehicles parked or stopped on the streets of the
City of Milwaukie, which have been designated for angle parking
shall be so parked or stopped that no part of said vehicle or its
load shall be over 17 feet from the curb line.

Section 3. No vehicle used for the transportation of liquid fuels
shall be parked or stopped on the streets of ~~Milwaukie~~ the City
of Milwaukie, Oregon, except when stopped pursuant to traffic
regulations or when actually engaged in loading or unloading.

Section 4. It hereby is declared to be unlawful to park or stop
any vehicle on the streets of the City of Milwaukie, in any
manner other than that manner set forth in Section 1 and 2 hereof;

Section 4. Every violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable
by a fine of not to exceed \$10.00 or imprisonment for 30 days in
jail or by both such fine and imprisonment.
