

ORDINANCE NO 482

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of 37th Street in Milwaukie, Oregon from the southerly line of the paved surface of Harvey Street to the northerly line of the paved surface of King Street, and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1.- That 37th Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, shall be improved from the southerly line of the paved surface of Harvey Street where the same intersects the center line of 37th Street, southerly to the paved surface of King Street. Said street to be improved in accordance with the plans and specifications for said improvement heretofore filed with the Recorder and adopted by a resolution of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon on the 13th day of May, 1946.

Section 2.- Inasmuch as said street is in such a condition that its improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
