

ORDINANCE NO. 485

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction of a sewer on 30th Street from the present sewer on Washington Street where the same intersects the center line of 30th Street; thence southerly along said 30th Street to the northerly line of a tract of land known as the Hoesly Tract, being also the southerly terminus of said 30th Street; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORIGIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. That a sewer, together with all catch basins, inlets and all things necessary in the construction thereof, shall be constructed from the present sewer on Washington Street where the same intersects the center line of 30th Street; thence southerly along said 30th Street to the northerly line of a tract of land known as the Hoesly Tract, being also the southerly terminus of said 30th Street; Said sewer to be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications for said sewer heretofore filed with the Recorder and adopted by resolution of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon on the 13th day of May, 1946.

Section 2. Inasmuch as said sewer is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
