

ORDINANCE No. 498

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER ON 30th STREET FROM THE PRESENT SEWER ON WASHINGTON STREET WHERE THE SAME INTERSECTS THE CENTER LINE OF SAID 30th STREET, THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG SAID 30th STREET TO THE NORTHERLY LINE OF A TRACT OF LAND KNOWN AS HOESLY TRACT BEING ALSO THE SOUTHERLY TERMINUS OF SAID 30th STREET; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:--

Section 1. That the assessment for the construction of a sewer on 30th Street from the present sewer on Washington Street where the same intersects the center line of said 30th Street; thence southerly along said 30th Street to the northerly line of a tract of land known of Hoesly Tract, being also the southerly terminus of 30th Street, is hereby declared to be levied according to Assessment Roll number Forty Eight (48) on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of said sewer is hereby declared to be the sum of \$4,882.19.

Section 3. In as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this; It is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said sewer be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
