

ORDINANCE NUMBER 505

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE SEWER CONNECTIONS, REQUIRING APPLICATION FOR PERMITS, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 21 and 110 AND ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES, OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. No person, firm or corporation shall construct, or reconstruct any sanitary sewer or storm drain within the City limits of Milwaukie on private property or in public ways without first making application and securing a permit therefor.

SECTION 2. Applications for permits to construct, or reconstruct, sanitary sewers or storm drains shall be made in writing in a form prescribed by the City Engineer and shall give the location of the property, the name of the owner, the name of the person or firm engaged to construct, or reconstruct, the proposed sanitary sewer or storm drain and such other information or plans as may be prescribed by the City Engineer.

SECTION 3. All applications to construct any sanitary sewer or storm drain shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.00 (If more than 50% of an existing line is to be reconstructed, then it shall be classed as new construction.) All applications to reconstruct any sanitary sewer or storm drain shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.00. (If less than 50% of an existing line is to be reconstructed, then it shall be classed as reconstruction.) If the work involved does not require the laying of any new line, it shall be classed as a repair job and no sewer permit inspection shall be required.

SECTION 4. A separate permit shall be required for each and every building.

SECTION 5. If the City Engineer approved the application, he shall issue a permit to construct, or reconstruct, which shall specify the location where said connection shall be made and shall be in a form prescribed by the City Engineer.

SECTION 6. Reasonable notice shall be given to the City Engineer to inspect all work in connection with the construction, or reconstruction, of any storm or sanitary drain or sewer while the work is still uncovered. All work shall be done according to the specifications prescribed by, and subject to, the approval of the City Engineer.

SECTION 7. Applications for permits to construct or reconstruct any sanitary sewer or storm drain must also conform with the provisions of any ordinance relating and requiring permits for making cuts or excavations in, ~~on~~ or under streets and alleys.

SECTION 8. Any person found guilty of violating any one of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00.

SECTION 9. That Ordinances Nos. 21 and 110 and any and all other ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

SECTION 10. Inasmuch as the provisions of the ordinance are such as to effect the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
