

ORDINANCE NUMBER 510

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NUMBERED 426 AND 467 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 474; PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THE TIME OF PARKING AUTOMOBILES AND OTHER VEHICLES ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In order to preserve the public safety and welfare the following Streets and portions of streets hereby are declared to require regulation of the length of time which any vehicle may remain parked thereon.

- A.- That portion of Main Street which lies between Harrison St. and Washington St.
- B.- That portion of Front Street which lies between Jackson St. and Jefferson St.
- C.- That portion of the south side of Monroe St. that lies between Front St. and Main Street.
- D.- That portion of Monroe St. which lies between Main St. and 21st. Street.
- E.- That portion of the north side of Jefferson St. that lies between Front Street and 21st Street.
- F.- That portion of Washington Street that lies between Front St. and 21st. Street.
- G.- That portion of 21st. Street that lies between Monroe Street and Washington St. (except 50 Ft. on the East side of 21st St. between the south side of Jefferson Street and a point 50 feet southerly therefrom)
- H.- That portion of the north side of Monroe Street that lies between Front Street and Main Street.
- I.- That portion of the South side of Monroe St. that lies between 21st. Street and 29th Street.
- J.- That portion of the east side of 21st. St. that lies between Harrison Street and Monroe Street.
- K.- That portion of the east side of 21st St. that lies between the southerly line of Jefferson St. and a point 50 feet southerly therefrom
- L.- That part of the west side of 23rd. St. that lies between Washington Street and the intersection of the westerly line of 23rd. Street with the northerly line of the land of the Union High School District No. 5 of Clackamas County, Oregon

Section 2. Except on Sundays and Holidays, on and after the 1st day of July 1948, it shall be unlawful, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. for any person to park any vehicle and allow the said vehicle to remain parked for longer than two consecutive hours on any part of the streets and portion of streets designated in Section 1, paragraphs A, B, C, D, E, F, and G hereof.

Section 3. Except on Sundays and Holidays, on and after the 1st day of July, 1948, it shall be unlawful, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M. for any person to park any vehicle and to allow the said vehicle to remain parked longer than 30 minutes consecutively on any portion of the Streets designated in Section 1, paragraph H thereof.

Section 4. On and after the 1st day of September, 1948 it shall be unlawful, at any time, to park any vehicle on the streets and parts of streets designated in Section 1, paragraphs I, J, K, and L thereof.

Section 5. Ordinances No. 426 and 467 shall remain in full force and effect in so far as they may be in conflict with this ordinance, and Ordinance No. 474 be and the same hereby is repealed. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are expressly repealed in so far as the provisions of those ordinances or parts of ordinances are in conflict herewith.

Section 6 Every person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine, upon conviction thereof, of not to exceed \$10.00.

Section 7. - In as much as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in that it is necessary to relieve the congested parking condition of certain streets, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
