

ORDINANCE NUMBER 513

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF THE NORTH TWO AND ONE-HALF FEET OF WASHINGTON STREET, FROM THE WEST LINE OF MAIN STREET TO THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE PORTLAND-OREGON CITY EAST SIDE HIGHWAY, IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, OREGON.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held, by the Council of Milwaukie on the 24th day of May 1948 and continued to the 14th day of June 1948, pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 259, Oregon Laws 1939, in relation to the proposed vacation of Washington Street between the west boundary of Main Street and the easterly boundary of the Portland-Oregon City East Side Highway, also known as Front Street or McLoughlin Boulevard, in the City of Milwaukie, and

WHEREAS, it appearing that notice has been duly given by publishing and posting the same as required by law, and it further appearing that it was the decision of the Council of Milwaukie that the said vacation was in the interest of the public and that the public interest will not be prejudiced in any respect, and that the property on neither side of the said portion of Washington Street will be disadvantageously affected, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1- That


Beginning at a point in the westerly boundary of Main Street in the City of Milwaukie that is North 10 deg. 00' west 25.00 feet distant, when measured along the center line of said Main Street and South 80 deg. 00' west 40.00 feet when measured at right angles to the center line of Main Street, from an iron pipe located at the intersection of Washington and Main Streets in said City; from said beginning point thence, continuing at right angles to the center line of Main Street, south 80 deg. West 210.00 feet to a point in the easterly right-of-way boundary of the Portland-Oregon City East Side Highway; thence, following said highway, South 10 deg. 00' East 2.50 feet; thence at right angles to the center line of Main Street, North 80 deg. 00' East 210.00 feet to the westerly boundary of the aforesaid Main Street extended southeasterly; thence, following the westerly boundary of Main Street extended southeasterly North 10 deg. 00' West 2.50 feet to the place of beginning of the tract herein described, containing 525.00 square feet more or less, be and the same is hereby declared to be vacated.
