

ORDINANCE NO. 527

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR AND RELAYING OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS, ALONG BOTH SIDES OF WASHINGTON, ELMER, OAK, RAILROAD AND MONROE STREETS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. (RCA)

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;—

Section 1. That curbs and sidewalks be constructed where none now exist; and that curbs and sidewalks be repaired and relaid where they now exist, but do not conform to the standards, as established by the City of Milwaukie, as to grade, alignment or quality, between the following termini and along the following lines; and along both side of the following Streets:—

Beginning at the intersection of Washington Street with the Easterly line of front Street; running thence easterly along both side of Washington Street to its intersection with Elmer Street; thence southeasterly along both sides of Elmer Street to its intersection with the westerly lines of 32nd Street and Oak Street; thence northeasterly along ~~Elmer Street~~ both sides of Oak Street to its intersection with the southwesterly line of Railroad Avenue; thence southeasterly along both sides of Railroad Avenue to its intersection with Monroe Street; thence along both sides of Monroe Street to its intersection with the westerly line of 42nd Street.

Section 2. Said curbs and sidewalks as constructed, reconstructed, repaired or relaid, shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefore which heretofore have been filed with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and are by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specification were adopted by resolution of the Council of the City of Milwaukie on the 11th day of July, 1949.

Section 3. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement by publishing notice there f in the Daily Journal of Commerce two times.

Section 4. Inasmuch as such improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public, therefore an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the passage thereof and its approval by the Mayor.
