

An Ordinance to provide for the improvement of Main street. Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of Milwaukie, southerly to south side of Foster Road.

Milwaukie does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Main street, Milwaukie, Oregon shall be improved from the north line of Milwaukie, southerly, to, the south line of the Foster Road, in conformity with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder, and which were adopted by resolution of the city Council on the 2d day of March 1911.

Section 2. Parties bidding on the work provided herein must state in the bid the time required for the completion of the entire improvements as herein specified after the approval of the Mayor and should the contractor fail to complete the work within the time specified in said contract, the city shall have the right to charge the contractor the sum of five dollars per day as liquated damages for each and every day, that the work shall remain uncompleted, after said special date, and such sum shall be deducted from said sum or the amount of the final payment. Section 3. Monthly estimates of the work to be done by the Engineer and an advance order shall be ordered at the first meeting of the Council following twenty per cent to be paid at the final acceptance of the work.  
Section 4. The contractor will be required to provide security in 1/5 the amount of the contract for the faithful performance of the work.
