

ORDINANCE NUMBER 535

Amending Ordinance Number 489

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3 AND 9 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 489, AND REGULATING AND LICENSING BUSINESSES, PROFESSIONS, PURSUITS AND OCCUPATIONS, FIXING THE LICENSE FEES THEREFOR AND PROVIDING THE MANNER IN WHICH APPLICATIONS FOR SAID LICENSES SHALL BE MADE.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance Number 489 be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The license fee for each business, profession, pursuit and occupation, shall be as follows:-

(a) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by not more than two individuals the license fee shall be (\$10.00) Ten Dollars.

(b) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by more than two individuals and not more than five individuals, the license fee shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)

(c) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by more than five individuals and not more than ten individuals, the license fee shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)

(d) If such business, pursuit, profession or occupation is carried on by more than ten individuals and not more than twenty individuals, the license fee shall be Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00)

(e) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by more than twenty individuals and not more than thirty individuals the license fee shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)

(f) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by more than thirty individuals and not more than fifty individuals, the license fee shall be Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00)

(g) If such business, profession, pursuit or occupation is carried on by more than fifty individuals the license fee shall be One hundred Dollars (\$100.00)

In arriving at the number of individuals carrying on such business, profession, pursuit or occupation, there shall be considered the proprietors thereof and all individuals regularly employed in such by said proprietors. If such is carried on by a corporation, all officers and employees of such corporation who devote the principal part of their time to such business, profession, pursuit or occupation shall be considered. If any person, firm or corporation shall have its principal place of business outside the City of Milwaukie, then only such proprietor, officers or employees shall be considered as are actually engaged in such business, profession, pursuit or occupation within the City of Milwaukie.

Section 2. That Section 9 of Ordinance Number 489 be amended to read as follows:-

Section 9 LICENSE, WHEN PAYABLE AND WHEN ISSUED.

On or before the first day of January 1950 and on or before the 1st day of each calendar year thereafter, every person, firm, association or corporation transacting business, or carrying on any trade, profession, pursuit or occupation within the City of Milwaukie, except as provided for in Section 4 hereof, shall make application to the City Treasurer, upon suitable blanks furnished by said City, for a license to carry on such business, trade, profession, pursuit or occupation and make payment of license fees as provided in Section 3 hereof.

The City Treasurer shall issue a license when a proper application has been made and payment of the required fee has been received; and every person shall keep and retain such license, and shall post the same in some convenient place in the premises or about the person of the person licensed; and shall exhibit the same to any police or other officer of the City of Milwaukie upon demand.

The application for each license shall set forth the business, trade, profession, pursuit or occupation for which such application is made, together with the name of the applicant, and the name of the agent, if so made, the general location of such business, trade, profession, occupation or pursuit, with the particular address, if possible, the number of persons regularly employed, including officers, proprietors and employees actually employed within the City of Milwaukee, and the amount of fee to be paid.

The license, when issued, shall be signed by the City Treasurer and shall specify the name of the persons, firm or corporation so licensed, and the business, trade, profession, occupation or pursuit for which the license is issued, the number of persons to which it applies and the amount of the license fees paid.
