ORDINANCE NO. 542

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING

for the grading and surfacing with gravel portions of 33rd, 34th and 35th Street, in Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon; directing the City Manager to give notice inviting proposals for the grading and graveling of said streets, by publication of the said notice in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least once; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Milwaukie does Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That portions of 33rd, 34th and 35th Streets be improved by grading and surfacing with gravel along the following lines and between the following terminals:

a. By grading and surfacing with gravel 33rd Street from Elmer Street southerly to a line perpendicular with said 33rd St. that would bisect Lots 17 and 20, Sernwood Addition.

b. By grading and surfacing with gravel 34th Street from Elmer Street southerly to Wister Street.

c. By grading and surfacing with gravel 35th Street from Elmer Street southerly to a line running from the southeast corner of Lot 10, Block 16, Quincy Addition to Milwaukie.

Section 2. Said grading and surfacing with gravel of said portions of 33rd Street, 34th Street and 35th Streets, shall substantially conform to the plans and specification therefore, which heretofore have been filed with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution of the Council of the City of Milwaukie on the 24th day of July, 1950.

Section 3. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvements, by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the public, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the passage thereof and its approval by the mayor.

Passed by the Council August 16th, 1950.
