

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LICENSE FEE ON ALL PUBLIC UTILITY CORPORATIONS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A FRANCHISE THEREFOR FROM THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

SECTION 1. Any public utility corporation operating within the limits of the City of Milwaukie, shall obtain a franchise therefor, before any such business may be conducted.

SECTION 2. In the event that any public utility corporation shall operate within in the City of Milwaukie without first obtaining a franchise to conduct such business, a license fee of (\$250.00) two hundred fifty dollars per month hereby is imposed for all months and parts of months during which such business is conducted without a franchise.

SECTION 3. Such license fee shall be payable monthly in advance; and no franchise shall be granted until all such license fees have been paid in full.

SECTION 4. It hereby is adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety; and that owing to urgent necessity, an emergency hereby is declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
