

ORDINANCE NO 558

AND ORDINANCE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, REPAIR, MAINTENANCE AND ALTERATION OF ELECTRIC WIRING AND APPARATUS: PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INSPECTOR THEREOF AND PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES: PROVIDING FOR PERMITS THEREFOR: PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF ELECTRICIANS: AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDIN AS FOLLOWS:*

Sec. 1. DEFINITION. The term person as used in this Ordinance shall be construed to include any person, firm, corporation, copartnership or association of persons.

Sec. 2. ADOPTION OF NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE. The National Electrical Code as recommended by the National Fire Protection Association is hereby adopted and made a part of this Ordinance as if it were herein set forth in full. The inspector of electric wiring and Aparatus shall at all times be governed by such Code and shall insist upon their inforcement.

Sec. 3 APPOINTMENT OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR. The City Manager shall appoint the Electrical Inspector, whose ^{duty shall be the} ~~main duty shall be the~~ supervision of and inspection of the installation, repair, maintenance and alteration of all Electric Wiring and Apparatus within the City of Milwaukie. The inspector shall report to the City Manager of the City of Milwaukie all infringements upon and violations of any of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Sec. 4. It shall be unlawful for any person to install or alter any Electric Wiring or Apparatus of any kind within the City of Milwaukie until such person shall have first secured from the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie a permit so to do. All applications for permits hereunder shall be made upon forms furnished by and approved the City Manager; and all such permits shall contain such requirements and specifications as may from time to time be adopted by the City of Milwaukie; all permits required under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be procured by the electrician having charge of the installation, repair or alteration.

Sec. 5. PERMIT FEES. Before the issuance of any permit hereunder

the applicant therefor shall pay to the recorder of the City of Milwaukee a fee of \$0.10 for each an every electrical outlet to be installed or altered.

Sec. 6. It shall be unlawful for any person to complete, enclose or place in service any electrical outlet, without first giving the Electrical inspector notice that the work is ready for inspection and until the Electrical Inspector shall have inspected and approved the same; provided that the Electrical Inspector shall make such inspection within 24 hours after receiving notice that the work is ready for inspection; and provided further that all subsequent inspections made necessary because of disapproval in the Electrical Inspector of repairs or installations as submitted shall be made upon a similar notice and within the same time as hereinbefore provided.

Sec. 7. DUTIES AND RIGHTS OF ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR. The Electrical Inspector shall have the authority to enter into and upon any premises at reasonable hours for the purpose of examining Electric Wiring and Apparatus. If he shall find any defects therein he shall notify the owner, agent, occupant, Electrician or other person in charge. If the inspection is made in connection with anything except new work or new installation, such person having the same in charge shall remedy the defect within ten days after receiving such notice.

Sec. 8. NOTICE TO ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR. Every contracting electrician and every electrician having charge of the installation or alteration of any Electric Wiring or Apparatus shall notify the Electrical Inspector of the time all work requiring a permit hereunder will be commenced. He shall also notify the Electrical Inspector from time to time ~~whenever~~ when any such electrical connections are ready for inspection.

Sec. 9. CONTROL OF CONSTRUCTION. All Electric Wiring shall be under the supervision of the Electrical Inspector, who hereby is empowered to stop further work, whenever in his judgment the work is being done contrary to the requirements of this ordinance.

Sec. 10. LICENSE. Any person ~~engaged in the Electrical business~~ within the City of Milwaukie, shall secure a license from the recorder annually. The annual license fee shall be \$ due and payable on the 1st day of January of each year. In case of failure to pay such annual license fee on or before 5 days after the same becomes due and payable, it shall be a misdemeanor for any person engaged in the Electrical business to do or perform any electric wiring of any kind or character within the City of Milwaukie until such license fee is paid.

Sec. 11. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS. Any person refusing or neglecting to comply with the requirements of this ordinance or violating any provisions thereof shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine in the sum of not more than \$ 100.00 or by imprisonment of not more than days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

If any person refuses to conform to the requirements of this ordinance after having been notified so to do by an enforcing official, each day's continuance of such violation shall be deemed a separate offense.
