

ORDINANCE NO 562

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PORTIONS OF 33rd, 34th and 35th STREETS, IN MILWAUKIE, CLATSOP COUNTY, OREGON, BY GRADING AND GRAVELING. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows;-

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement by grading and surfacing with gravel of the portions of 33rd, 34th and 35th Streets, Milwaukie, Oregon, described as follows;-

(a) 33rd Street from Elmer Street southerly to a line perpendicular with said 33rd Street, that would bisect Lots 17 and 20, Fernwood Addition.

(b) 34th Street from Elmer Street southerly to Wister Street.

(c) 35th Street from Elmer Street southerly to a line running from the Southeast corner of Lot 10, Block 16, Quincy Addition to Milwaukie, to the Southwest corner of Lot 25, Block 15, Quincy Addition to Milwaukie;

hereby is declared and levied according to Assessment Roll numbered Fifty Four (54), on file in the office of the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of the improvement of said portions of said Street is declared to be the sum of \$11,632.08.

Section 3. In as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this; that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Streets be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit, therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and its approval by the mayor.

Read the first time this 26th day of November, 1951.

Read the second time and passed the 12 day of December, 1951
