

ORDINANCE NO. 564

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE GRADING AND SURFACING WITH GRAVEL OF PENZANCE STREET FOR ITS ENTIRE LENGTH: AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO GIVE NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS FOR SUCH GRADING AND GRAVELING, BY PUBLICATION OF SAID NOTICE IN THE DAILY JOURNAL OF COMMERCE AT LEAST ONCE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows;

Section 1. That Penzance Street be improved for its entire length by grading the said street 36 feet in width and graveling the same 36 feet in width, according to plans and specification now on file.

Section 2. The said grading and surfacing with gravel of said Penzance Street, shall substantially conform to the plans and specification therefore which have heretofore been filed with the City Recorder; and which said plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution of the Council of the City of Milwaukie, by Resolution No. 1, 1952 on the 24 day of March, 1952.

Section 3. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof at least once in the Daily Journal of Commerce.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after the passage hereof and its approval by the mayor.

Read the first time April 28th, 1952

Read the second time and passed by the Council May 12th, 1952.
