ORDINANCE NO. 566

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PORTIONS OF MONROE AND CAMPBELL STREETS BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF SUCH PORTION THEREOF.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS;-

Section 1. That portions of Monroe and Campbell streets be improved by the construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides of said portions thereof, along the following line and between the following termini; - Beginning at the intersection of said Monroe Street with the easterly line of 29th Street; running thence easterly along both side of Monroe Street to its intersection with Campbell Street; thence along both sides of Campbell street south-easterly to its interscetion with the northwesterly line of Oak Street.

Section 2. The construction of said curb and sidewalk shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefore, which have heretofore been filed with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are refered to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted by the Council of the City of Milwaukie by Resolution No 3, 1952 on the 24 day of March, 1952.

Section 3. That upon the taking ~~force~~ effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, therefore an emergency is hereby decalred to exist and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Read the second time and passed the 12th day of May, 1952.
