

ORDINANCE NUMBER 567

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 27th STREET BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF SAID 27th STREET, FROM WASHINGTON STREET TO LAKE ROAD, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS, AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 27th Street be improved by construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides thereof, where none now exist or where such do exist but do not conform to the city standards as to alignment, grade or quality, between the following termini:-

Beginning at the intersection of 27th Street with the southerly line of Washington Street; running thence southerly to the northerly line of Lake Road.

Section 2. Said improvement by the construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides of 27th Street, shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications therefore now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to, and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution No. 4-1952 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie on the 14th day of April, 1952.

Section 3. That upon the taking effect of this Ordinance the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after the passage thereof and its approval by the Mayor.
