

ORDINANCE NUMBER 572

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PORTIONS OF MONROE AND CAMPBELL STREETS BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. The assessment for the construct on of curbs and sidewalks along both sides of the following described portions of Monroe and Campbell Streets:-

Beginning at the intersection of said Monroe Street with the Easterly line of 29th Street, running thence easterly along both sides of Monroe Street to its intersection of Campbell Street; thence along both sides of Campbell street southerly to its intersection with the northwesterly line of Oak Street,

hereby is declared and levied as set forth in Assessment Roll numbered fifty-six (56), now on file in the office of the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of the improvement made by the construction of said curbs and sidewalks is declared to be the sum of \$5458.28

Section 3. In as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this; That it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said improvement be declared and levied in order to secure funds with which to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Now therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Read the second time and passed by the Council this 12 day of Jan 1953
