

ORDINANCE NUMBER 575

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FIVE YEAR FRANCHISE TO GEORGE DEERING, DOING BUSINESS AS MILWAUKIE SANITARY SERVICE, TO COLLECT GARBAGE IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE; FIXING THE CHARGES TO BE MADE THEREFOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Milwaukie does hereby grant to George Deering, doing business as Milwaukie Sanitary Service, the sole and exclusive privilege of collecting and removing garbage, swill, offal, dead animals, tin cans and all other similar waste in the City of Milwaukie for the period of five years from the first day of January, 1953 to the thirty-first day of December, 1958; which privilege shall not be transferable; and he, during such term is authorized to make the following charges for such service.

RESIDENTIAL RATES

Section 2. At all residences the charge shall not exceed the following: Per. 25 gallon can One collection per week, 1 can \$1.25 per month, 2 cans, \$2.00 per month. Two collections per week; One can \$2.50 per month, two cans, \$3.50 per month; each additional container at 25 cents per can.

COMMERCIAL RATES:

Section 3. At Apartments, Hotels, Schools, Theaters and any business store or shop, the charges shall be as follows: One collection per week service, one can \$1.50 per month; two cans \$2.50 per month; Two collections per week service, One can \$3.50 per month, Two cans \$4.00 per month; Three collections per week; One can \$3.50 per month, Two cans, \$5.00 per month; each additional can 25 cents.

BY SPECIAL COLLECTION.

Section 4. Removal of cans and broken bottles, excluding garbage picked up at the time of a regular trip, placed in a container not to exceed 30 gallons per container, the charge shall be 75 cents per container and old water boilers and bed springs, 50 cents each

BULK DISPOSAL BY LOAD.

Section 5. Light rubbish, load not to exceed 4 cubic yards, placed at the curb \$8.00, in back yards and basements \$10.00 each load.

REMOVAL OF DEAD ANIMALS

Section 6. Dead animals, such as dogs and cats, 50 cents each.

DISPOSAL PROVISIONS

Section 7. That said Milwaukie Sanitary Service shall, at its own expense, maintain a place satisfactory to the City Council for the disposal of all garbage collected under this franchise, at a proper place and in a sanitary condition, and with proper vehicles.

TELEPHONE SERVICE:

Section 8. That it will maintain, under the name of Milwaukie Sanitary Service a Telephone with attendant, during all regular business hours.

FRANCHISE FEE

Section 9. That the Milwaukie Sanitary Service Service agrees to pay to the City of Milwaukie for this franchise the sum of \$25.00 per year, on or before the first day of March of each year during the term hereof.

Section 10. In as much as the provisions of this ordinance are such as to effect the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the provisions of this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
