

ORDINANCE NO. 587  
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF STREETS BY ITINERANT MERCHANTS PROVIDING A LICENSE THEREFOR AND FIXING A PENALTY.

The City of Milwaukie does ordain as follows:—

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be unlawful to use any street in the City of Milwaukie for the purpose of selling any goods wares or merchandise, without obtaining a license therefor as hereinafter specified.

Section 2. Any person desiring to sell goods, wares or merchandise on any of the streets of Milwaukie shall first apply for a license therefor; and shall file with the City Recorder such application, which shall state the name of applicant, residence of applicant, the kind of goods, wares or merchandise to be sold, the exact location where such sales will be conducted; and the hours during which, he will so engage, the name of the manufacturer of such merchandise; and furnish the City with a corporate bond, or by a bond executed by two freeholder residing within the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, in a sum of not less than \$1,000.00, condition on the faithful compliance with all terms and conditions of the license granted on such application; and an agreement to comply with all the laws of the state of Oregon and Ordinances of the City of Milwaukie.

Section 3. If the application and bond is found to be acceptable; the City manager shall issue a license to such person to use the streets of the City of Milwaukie to sell such merchandise, at a particular location which shall be set forth in said License, upon payment of the following fees:

License fee for one day \$10.00.  
License fee for one week \$25.00

Section 4. If at any time after the granting of such license the City manager shall ascertain that such licensee is obstructing the flow of either foot or vehicular traffic, he shall have the right to move such licensee to a different location than the one prescribed in the license; or cancel such license; if such license is cancelled there shall be refunded to licensee such part of the fee as has not been used on a pro rata basis.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not less than \$100.00.
