

ORDINANCE NUMBER 588

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRAINING OF ANY SURFACE WATER, GROUND WATER OR WATER DRAINED FROM ANY ROOF INTO THE MILWAUKIE SANITARY SEWER OR ANY LATERALS THERE TO; ALSO PROHIBITING THE EMPTYING OF ANY OIL, INDUSTRIAL WASTE OR CHEMICAL SUBSTANCE THAT WOULD BE DELECTERIOUS TO THE MILWAUKIE SANITARY SEWER OR TO THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The draining of any surface water, ground water or water drained from the roof of any building within the City of Milwaukee, into the Milwaukee Sanitary Sewer or any extensions thereof, or lateral thereto is hereby prohibited

Section 2. The captying of any oil, industrial waste or chemical substance that would be delecterious to the Milwaukee Sanitary Sewer or the sewage treatment plant of the City of Milwaukee, hereby is prohibited.

Section 3. No building permit shall be issued, or water service furnished, for any structure that does not in its plans show that adequate provision has been made for roof drainage, and surface water and ground water drainage of premises upon which such structure is to be erected, in some manner other than by use of the Milwaukee Sanitary Sewer.

Section 4. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars; and each day that such violation continues shall be considered as a separate offence.
