

ORDINANCE NUMBER 590

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 32nd STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET NORTH TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARVEY STREET, BY CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF WHERE NONE EXISTED AND WHERE THEY DID EXIST BUT DID NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1, That the assessment for the improvement of 32nd Street from its intersection with Harrison^{street} north to its intersection with Harvey Street, by construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to city standard as to alignment, grade or quality, is hereby declared and levied according to the ASSESSMENT ROLL numbered Fifty-eight (58) now on file with the Recorder of Milw aukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of the improvement of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Three thousand nine hundred seventy-five dollars and twenty-five cents (\$3,975.25)

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said street be declared and levied in order to secure funds fo pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its apporval by the Mayor.
