

ORDINANCE NUMBER 591

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 32nd STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELMER STREET SOUTHERLY TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WISTER STREET, BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE EXISTED AND WHERE THEY DID EXIST BUT DID NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 That the assessment for the improvement of 32nd Street from its intersection with Elmer Street southerly to its intersection with Wister Street, by construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to city standards as to alignment, grade or quality, is hereby declared and levied, according to the ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBERED FIFTY-NINE (59) now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvement of the said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Eight thousand one hundred eighty-one and .01/100 (\$8,181.01) Dollars.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said street be declared and levied in order to secure the funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor
