

ORDINANCE NUMBER 594

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 28th STREET FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAKE ROAD SOUTHERLY TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAKESIDE AVENUE, BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE EXISTED AND WHERE THEY DID EXIST BUT DID NOT CONFLRM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of 28th Street from its intersection with Lake Road southerly to its intersection with Lake Side Avenue by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways along both sides thereof, where none existed and where they did exist but did not conform to city standards as to alignment, grade or quality, is hereby declared and levied according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBERED SIXTY-ONE (1), now on file with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said improvement of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Four thousand One hundred forty-eight and 78/100 (\$4,148.78) Dollars

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost thereof and maintain public credit. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
