

ORDINANCE NUMBER 595

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PENZANCE STREET BY GRADING AND GRAVELING THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the assessment for the improvement of Penzance Street by the grading and graveling thereof is hereby declared and levied, according to ASSESSMENT ROLL NUMBERED SIXTY-TWO (62)

Section 2. That the entire cost of the said improvement of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of Seven hundred eighty-nine and 25/100 (\$789.25) Dollars

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of the improvement of said Street be declared and levied in order to secure funds to pay the cost and maintain public credit. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
