ORDINANCE NUMBER 599

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 31st STREET BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO GRADE, ALIGNMENT OR QUALITY: FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELMER STREET SOUTHERLY TO ITS SOUTHERLY TERMINUS. *And declaring an emergency.*

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 31st Street from its intersection with Elmer Street southerly to its southerly terminus, be improved by construction of curbs and sidewalks along both sides thereof, where none now exist or where such as do exist do not conform to city standards as to alignment, grade or quality, between the following termini:-

Beginning at the intersection of the southerly line of Elmer Street; thence southerly along said ~~31st~~ Street to its southerly terminus.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and by this reference made a part of this ordinance; and which plans and specifications were adopted by Resolution No. 6, 1954 by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, on the 12th day of April, 1954.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this ordinance, the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof in the Drive at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
