

ORDINANCE NUMBER 613

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF 34th STREET BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS, ALONG BOTH SIDES THEREOF, WHERE NONE NOW EXIST AND WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO GRADE, ALIGNMENT OR QUALITY; FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAKE ROAD NORTHERLY TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That 34th Street from its intersection with Lake Road, northerly to its intersection with Washington Street be improved by the construction of curbs, sidewalks and driveways, along both sides thereof, where none now exists or where they do exist, but do not conform to City standards as to alignment, grade or quality, between the following termini.

Beginning at the intersection of 34th Street with the northerly line of Lake Road; thence northerly along 34th Street to its intersection with the southerly line of Washington Street.

Section 2. Said improvement shall substantially conform to the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance; and which said plans and specifications were adopted and approved by Resolution Number 1,1955.

Section 3. That on the taking effect of this Ordinance, the City Manager, without delay, shall give notice inviting proposals for the construction of said improvement, by publishing notice thereof in the Daily Journal of Commerce, at least one time.

Section 4. Inasmuch as said improvement is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
