

CHARTER AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NUMBER 615

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, IN THE COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS AND STATE OF OREGON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE FOR THEIR ADOPTION OR REJECTION THE FOLLOWING PROPOSAL FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON:

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED:-- A BILL FOR AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, BY AMENDING CHAPTER I THEREOF BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 1 (a), WHICH MAY BE DESIGNATED "ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY CITY" PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF PART OF THE D.L.C. OF Wm.MEEK AND WIFE, IN T. 1 S., R. 1 E., OF THE W.M., CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON AS HEREIN MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a special city election shall be held in the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon on the 30th day of August, 1955, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of the said City of Milwaukie for their adoption or rejection the following proposal for an amendment to the City Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon.

PROPOSAL FOR CHARTER AMENDMENT

A Bill for an Act to amend the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon by amending Chapter I thereof by adding thereto Section 1 (a), to be designated "ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY CITY", providing for the annexation of part of the D.L.C. of Wm.Meek and wife, in T. 1 S.;R. 1 E.; of the W.M., Clackamas County as more specifically described herein, said land being territory now completely surrounded by the corporate limits and boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON:

Section 1. That Chapter I of the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, be amended by adding thereto Section 1 (a), to be designated "ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY CITY" to read as follows:

Section 1 (a). Annexation of Territory Surrounded by City.
That the following described land, to-wit:

Part of the D.L.C. of Wm.Meek and wife, in T. 1 S., R. 1 E., of the W.M., Clackamas County, Oregon, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pipe driven at a point that is north 8° 58' west 50 feet distant from an iron pipe driven in the north boundary of Lewelling Park, Clackamas County Oregon, at a point that is South 81° 02' west 140 feet distant from the northeast corner of Lot 8, Block 3, Lewelling Park, according to the official plat thereof as the same is duly reworded in Book 7, page 14, Record of Townplats of Clackamas County, running thence north 8° 58' West 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 81° 02' east 495.5 feet to an iron pipe in the west boundary of Streib's First

Addition to Milwaukie, Oregon, thence tracing the west boundary of said Townplat South 1° 31' east 100.85 feet to an iron pipe, which point is South 1° 31' east 398.45 feet distant from a basalt stone set in the northwest corner of said townplat, thence south 1° 31' east tracing the west boundary of said town plat to an iron bar at the northwest corner of Tract No 1 of said townplat; thence tracing the west boundary of said townplat south 9° 09' east 56.5 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 4, Block 3, Lewelling Park; thence tracing the north boundary of Block 3, of said Lewelling Park south 80° 10' west 336.79 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 3 of said Lewelling Park; thence North 8° 58' west 54.6 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 8, Block 3, Lewelling Park; thence tracing the north boundary of said Lewelling Park South 81° 02' west 140 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 9° 58' west 50 feet to the place of beginning.

is hereby annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon.

Section 2. That a copy of the foregoing proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon be filed with the City Clerk as required by Section 221.210, Oregon Revised Statutes.

Section 3. The following voting precincts hereby are established for said election.

Precinct 1 shall consist of the voting precincts 1,2 and 3 as established by the County Clerk of Clackamas County.

Precinct 2 shall consist of the voting precincts 4,5 and 6 as established by the County Clerk of Clackamas County.

The following named places are hereby designated as the polling places for said election, and the following named persons are hereby designated and appointed as and for Judges and Clerks of election, to act at said polling places for said election on said date, to-wit:

Precinct 1. Polling place, City Hall, 926 Main Street in said Milwaukie. Bernice Sperr, Chairman; Emma Gritzmaker and Marjorie Baxter, Judges; Marian Marrison and Lois Thompson, Clerks.

Precinct 2. Polling place, Administration Building, Hillside Park, in said Milwaukie. Gwen McCartney, Chairman; Etna Olson and Hilda Burdick, Judges; Maude Espejo and Etha Tate, Clerks.

Section 4. EMERGENCY. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety. The reason why this Ordinance should become immediately effective are: That it is urgently necessary that Main Street of the City be extended northward so as to provide for the expeditious and safe flow of the volume of vehicular traffic through said city, and the safety of the public; that a portion of the territory proposed to be annexed is necessarily required for the extension of said Main Street, that the city cannot condemn the portion of said property for said purpose until the same becomes annexed to the City; that it is imperative to begin condemnation proceedings as soon as possible; and in order to make use of available fill materials from nearby properties. By reason of the foregoing an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
