

ORDINANCE NUMBER 622

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 139, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 479, AND FIXING THE CHARGE TO BE MADE FOR SERVICE CONNECTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 139, as amended by Section 1 of Ordinance No. 479, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 4. All connections shall be made by the City of Milwaukie, which shall make a charge therefor in accordance with the following schedule:

- Installation where 3/4 inch meter is used \$ 75.00
- Installation where 1 inch meter is used 100.00
- Installation where 1 1/2 inch meter is used 125.00 "

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that the fixing of increased charges to be made for the said service connections is immediately necessary to preserve and maintain the public credit, therefore, an emergency is adjudged and declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
