

ORDINANCE NUMBER 627

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROCEDURE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, DISPENSING WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF SUCH ANNEXATION TO THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY, FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON AT WHICH TIME THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY MAY APPEAR AND BE HEARD ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION, AND DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That procedure to annex the following described territory, which is contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, to-wit:-

Beginning at a concrete monument at the southwest corner of SELLWOOD GARDENS, a Townplat recorded in Volume 10, Page 25, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS for Clackamas County, Oregon; thence North $89^{\circ}15'$ East, 1009.50 feet to the southeast corner of said SELLWOOD GARDENS; thence continuing North $89^{\circ}15'$ East, 283.00 feet to the southeast corner of ROSS & WALKERS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD GARDENS, a Townplat recorded in Volume 11, Page 5, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence NORTH $8^{\circ}04'$ West 750.00 feet along the east boundary of said ROSS & WALKERS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD GARDENS; thence North $80^{\circ}50'$ East, 30.00 feet to the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way; thence North $9^{\circ}10'$ West, following the westerly right of way of said Southern Pacific Railroad, to its intersection with the Multnomah County line, which is also the north boundary of Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W.M.; thence North $89^{\circ}41'$ West along the north boundary of said Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., to the northwest corner of said Section 25; thence continuing westerly, along the north boundary of Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., to its intersection with the west line of the George Wills D.L.C.; thence South $4^{\circ}39'$ East, along the west line of the said George Wills D.L.C., which is also the west line of both ROSS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD, a Townplat recorded in Volume 6, Page 27, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS, and said SELLWOOD GARDENS, to the place of beginning, all in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, comprising all of that property bounded by the westerly right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad; the south and east lines of Multnomah County; and the north line of the City of Milwaukie and its westerly extension thereof.

be and the same hereby is initiated and undertaken pursuant to the provisions of Sections 222.120, 222.130, 222.140, 222.150, and 222.170 of OREGON REVISED STATUTES.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon does hereby elect to dispense with, and does hereby dispense with submitting the question of the annexation of the territory described in Section 1 of this Ordinance to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 3 That the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon hereby fixes the 9th day of January 1956, at the hour of eight (8:30) o'clock P.M., in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, as the time and place for a public hearing before the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at which time the registered voters of said City may appear and be heard on the question of such annexation.

Section 4. That notice of the time and place of said hearing be published in the Milwaukie Review, a paper of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie Oregon, once each week for two successive weeks prior to the said date fixed for public hearing, and that the Chief of Police of the City of Milwaukie, post in four (4) public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, written notice of said hearing and the time and place thereof for a like period of time.
