

ORDINANCE NUMBER 630

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, ANNEXED TO THE SAID CITY UPON THE CONDITION THAT THE MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST IN THE SAID TERRITORY IS IN FAVOR OF ANNEXATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, having heretofore, by Ordinance No. 627, duly passed on the 13th day of December, 1955, and duly approved by the Mayor of said City, on the 13th day of December, 1955, dispensed with submitting the question of the annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and having heretofore, by said Ordinance, fixed the 9th day of January, 1956, as the day for public hearing at which time the registered voters of said City might appear and be heard on the question of said annexation before it, and all required notices relating to such hearing having been heretofore published and posted as required by the provisions of Section 222.120, Oregon Revised Statutes, and the public hearing having been had by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie pursuant to such notices, and no registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, appearing at said hearing who protested said annexation, IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the following described territory, situated in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at a concrete monument at the southwest corner of SELLWOOD GARDENS, a Townplat recorded in Volume 10, Page 25, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS for Clackamas County, Oregon; thence North 89° 15' East, 1009.50 feet to the southeast corner of said SELLWOOD GARDENS; thence continuing North 39° 15' East, 283.00 feet to the southeast corner of ROSS & WALKERS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD GARDENS, a Townplat recorded in Volume 11, Page 5, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence NORTH 8° 04' West 750.00 feet along the east boundary of said ROSS & WALKERS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD GARDENS; thence North 80° 50' East, 30.00 feet to the Southern Pacific Railroad right of way; thence North 9° 10' West, following the westerly right of way of said Southern Pacific Railroad, to its intersection with the Multnomah County line, which is also the north boundary of Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E. W.M.; thence North 89° 41' West along the north boundary of said Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., to the northwest corner of said Section 25; thence continuing westerly, along the north boundary of Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., to its intersection with the west line of the George Wills D.L.C.; thence South 4° 39' East, along the west line of the said George Wills D.L.C., which

is also the west line of both ROSS ADDITION TO SELLWOOD, a Townplat recorded in Volume 6, Page 27, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS, and said SELLWOOD GARDENS, to the place of beginning, all in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, comprising all of that property bounded by the westerly right of way of the Southern Pacific Railroad; the south and west lines of Multnomah County; and the north line of the City of Milwaukie and its westerly extension thereof.

being territory contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast in the said territory by the registered voters residing within said territory at a special election hereafter to be held in said territory upon the question of such annexation is in favor of such annexation.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and, owing to the urgent necessity of maintaining the public credit, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Read the second time and unanimously passed by all of the members of the City Council this 9th day of January, 1956
