

ORDINANCE NUMBER 238

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 530 BY PROVIDING NEW REGULATIONS FOR THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES UPON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section <sup>2</sup>~~1~~ of Ordinance No. 530 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section <sup>2</sup>~~1~~. Except where angle parking is indicated by stripes~~es~~ painted or otherwise durably marked on the street, no person shall stand or park a motor vehicle upon any street in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, other than parallel with the edge of the street, headed in the direction of lawful traffic movement and with the right-hand wheels of the motor vehicle not ~~under~~ twelve (12) inches from the curb or edge of the street. Whenever individual parking spaces for parking parallel with the curb or the edge of the street have been painted or durably marked on the curbing or any street in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at each space so marked off it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle in such a way that said vehicle shall not be entirely within the limits so designated."

Section <sup>3</sup>~~2~~. That Section <sup>3</sup>~~1~~ of Ordinance No. 530 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section <sup>3</sup>~~2~~. Upon those streets in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, which have been signed or marked by stripes painted on the streets for angle parking, no person shall park or stand a motor vehicle other than at the angle to the curb or roadway indicated by such signs or markings, nor shall any person stand or park any motor vehicle upon any such street so signed or marked for angle parking unless the same is entirely within the limits of the space so designated, and unless the right front wheel of such motor vehicle is brought to rest against the curb or edge of any such street."

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently and immediately necessary for the proper and effective enforcement of the traffic laws of said city and for the protection of all persons using the streets and highways within said city; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage and the signing by the Mayor.

Read the first time this 26th day of March, 1956.


Read the second time and passed upon a unanimous vote of all of the members of the City Council this 26th day of March, 1956.
