

ORDINANCE NUMBER 648

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE ASSESSMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER ALONG MAIN STREET, A DISTANCE OF 1354 FEET SOUTHERLY FROM THE SEWER PRESENTLY IN THE CENTER LINE OF HARVESTER DRIVE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MAIN STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1, The assessment for the construction of a sanitary sewer along Main Street, a distance of 1354 feet southerly from the Sewer presently in the center line of Harvester Drive at its intersection with Main Street, in Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, hereby is declared and levied as set forth in Assessment Roll Numbered SIXTY-EIGHT (68) now on file in the office of the City Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. The whole cost of the improvement made by the construction of a sanitary sewer along Main Street, a distance of 1354 feet southerly from the sewer presently in Harvester Drive at its intersection with Main Street is declared to be the sum of \$3835.02.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the inhabitants thereof, in this; That it is necessary that the assessment to pay the cost of said improvement be declared and levied in order to secure funds with which to pay the cost thereof and maintain the public credit. Therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and signing by the Mayor.
