

ORDINANCE NUMBER 651

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AN ANNEXATION ELECTION WITHIN THE TERRITORY BOUNDED AS THEREIN DESCRIBED, FIXING THE DATE OF SUCH ELECTION AND THE HOURS DURING WHICH THE POLLS WILL BE OPEN, DESIGNATING THE LOCATIONS OF THE POLLING PLACES WITHIN SAID TERRITORY, DESIGNATING THE NAMES OF THE JUDGES AND CLERKS OF SAID ELECTION, DIRECTING THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, having heretofore by Ordinance Number 650 declared the following territory located in Clackamas County, Oregon, and contiguous to the present boundaries of said city to-wit:-

1. Beginning at a point of intersection of the Westerly right-of-way boundary of the Southern Pacific Company and the Clackamas-Multnomah County line, in the north boundary of Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E. of the W. M.; thence
2. in an Easterly direction, following the Clackamas-Multnomah County line to the northwest corner of the tract of land deeded to Wayne H. Harvey and wife as recorded in Book 436 Page 301 of Records of Deeds of Clackamas County, Oregon and located in the George Wills D.L.C. No. 58 in Section 25, T. 1 S., R. 1 E. of the W. M.; thence
3. tracing said west line of said Harvey Tract, South 0 degrees 30' 00" West to the southwest corner thereof; thence
4. tracing the southerly line of said Harvey Tract, South 70 degrees 15' 30" East a distance of 102.17 feet to the southeast corner thereof; thence
5. tracing the east line of said Harvey Tract North 0 degrees 30' 00" East to the northeast corner thereof, located in the Clackamas-Multnomah County line; thence
6. tracing said County line in an Easterly direction to a point of intersection with the west line of the CARLSRUHE SUBDIVISION recorded in Book 12 on Page 15, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
7. tracing the west boundary of said subdivision in a Southerly direction to the southwest corner thereof; thence
8. Southeasterly along the south-westerly boundary of the said CARLSRUHE SUBDIVISION to the northwest corner of ELLECREST, recorded in Book 20 on Page 9 Record of Townplats; thence
9. tracing the west boundary of said ELLECREST, South 0 degrees 11' East to the southwest corner thereof; thence
10. continuing South 0 degrees 11' East to the southerly right-of-way boundary of the Portland Traction Company Railroad; thence
11. tracing the last mentioned direction to an angular corner in the northerly boundary of Lot 9 of the GIBSON SUBDIVISION OF THE LOGUS TRACT recorded in Book 7 on Page 47 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
12. tracing the north line of said Lot 9 in a Westerly direction a distance of 32.67 feet to the northwest corner thereof; thence
13. tracing the west line of said GIBSON SUBDIVISION in a Southerly direction to the northwest corner of Tract 3, LOGUS TRACTS, recorded in Book 6 on Page 1 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
14. tracing the west boundary of said Tract 3, South to the said Wills Claim south boundary; thence
15. Westerly along said Claim boundary to the westerly boundary of Lot 8 of said LOGUS TRACTS extended North; thence
16. tracing the west boundary and said extension of Lot 8 in a Southerly direction to a point of intersection with the south boundary of Logus Road; thence
17. tracing the said south boundary of Logus Road in a Westerly direction to a point of intersection with the east boundary of GLOVER ROAD, also known as S. E. 43rd AVENUE; thence
18. tracing the easterly boundary of GLOVER ROAD in Southerly direction to a point of intersection with the easterly extension of the southerly boundary of DRAKE STREET; thence
19. tracing the southerly boundary of DRAKE STREET and the easterly extension thereof, West to a point of intersection within the southerly extension of the boundary between Lots 50 and 51 MARCHBANKS, a Townplat recorded in Book 3 on Page 9 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
20. North 40 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 50; thence
21. tracing the City boundary of Milwaukie as per Ordinance 606, in a Northerly and Westerly direction to the northwest corner of the territory described in Ordinance 606 in the south boundary of Harvey Street; thence
22. along the east boundary of 40th Street to the south boundary of the said George Wills Claim; thence
23. tracing the said Wills Claim boundary in a Westerly direction to the West boundary of S. E. 37th AVENUE; thence
24. tracing the present city boundary in a southerly direction to the southeast corner of ROCKWOOD ACRES, recorded in Book 7 on Page 53 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
25. tracing the present city boundary of Milwaukie along the south line of said ROCKWOOD ACRES in a Westerly direction to a point of intersection with the easterly boundary of S. E. 32nd AVENUE; thence
26. tracing the easterly boundary of S. E. 32nd Avenue in a Southerly direction to a point of intersection with the southerly line of BONNIE VIEW ACRES NO. 4, recorded in Book 16 on Page 19 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS, extended; thence
27. tracing the southerly boundary of said BONNIE VIEW ACRES and the easterly extension thereof along the present city boundary of Milwaukie, in a Westerly direction to a point of intersection with the westerly right-of-way of the main line of the Southern Pacific Company; thence
28. tracing the said right-of-way line and the line of the present city boundary of Milwaukie in a Southeasterly direction to the northerly boundary of Block 3 BROWNELL ACRES, recorded in Book 16 on Page 27 RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence
29. tracing the north line of BROWNELL ACRES and the present city boundary of Milwaukie in a Westerly direction to the Northeast corner of STREIB'S FIRST ADDITION, recorded in Book 8 on Page 20, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS, located in the westerly right-of-way line of the Beaverton-Willsburg branch of the Southern Pacific Company; thence
30. tracing the westerly line of said right-of-way and the westerly right-of-way boundary of the main line of said railroad in a Northerly direction to the place of beginning.

to be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast by the registered voters residing within said territory is in favor of annexation, it is hereby ordered that an annexation election be held within the said territory submitting to the registered voters residing within said territory the question of whether or not such territory shall be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

Section 2. The date of said annexation election herein ordered is hereby fixed as the fourteenth (14) day of September, 1956. The time during which the polls shall be continuously open is hereby fixed as between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. on said day. The location of the polling places used during the conduct

of said election and at which any registered voter residing within the boundaries of the territory hereinabove described may cast his or her ballot, ~~Wade/Wade~~ are hereby designated and fixed as follows:

THE ARDENWALD WATER OFFICE, 8955 S.E. 32nd Avenue Portland, Zone 22, Oregon. within said territory.

A RESIDENCE AT 4420 S.E. Roswell Street (formerly known as Derry Avenue) Milwaukie, Zone 22, Oregon, within said territory.

Section 3. The following registered voters, residing within said territory are hereby appointed and designated to act as judges and clerks of said election in the capacities set forth opposite their names.

Section 4. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to prepare a proper notice of said election in the manner and form required by Section 222.130 Oregon Revised Statutes, and to cause the same to be published once each week for four successive weeks prior to said election, in the Milwaukie Review, a paper of general circulation in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon. The City Recorder is further ordered and directed to post a like notice of election in four public places within the said territory for a like period of time.

Section 5. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Milwaukie and the inhabitants thereof, in this, that it is urgently required for the purpose of maintaining public credit and the alleviation of sewage and drainage conditions which presently tend to impair the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Milwaukie and adjacent territory, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage by the City Council and its signing by the Mayor.
